The Infinity Code

- 1) All Hebrew letters have a numeric value.
- 2) Therefore, if all Hebrew letters have numerical values, all Hebrew words must have numeric values as well.
- 3) Accordingly, if you take the value of the Hebrew word and go to that chapter in the bible, you will find one or more of the following:
 - a) The actual word in the text.
 - b) A synonym (or sometimes an antonym) of the word in the text.
 - c) A discussion of the word or its concept in the text.

The Infinity Code

1. All Hebrew letters have a numeric value.
2. Therefore, if all Hebrew letters have numerical values, all Hebrew words must have numeric values as well.
3. Accordingly, if you take the value of the Hebrew word and go to that chapter in the bible, you will find one or more of the following:
 - a) The actual word in the text.
 - b) A synonym (or sometimes an antonym of the word in the text.
 - c) A discussion of the word or its concept in the text.
