# Psalms 83

...but money answereth all things. (Ecclesiastes 10:19c)

- Keep not thou silence, O El: hold not thy peace, and be not still, O Elohim.
- For, lo, thine enemies make a tumult: and they that hate thee have lifted up the head.
- They have taken crafty counsel against thy people and consulted against thy hidden ones. (Psalms 83:1-3)

# Psalms 83:4-5

...but money answereth all things. (Ecclesiastes 10:19c)

- They have said, Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation; that the name of Israel may be no more in remembrance.
  - The Palestinians have placed this statement in their charter.
- For they have consulted together with one consent: they are confederate against thee:
  - These nations have made an agreements, but they still retain their individual identities as nations.

  - Edom is Esau (Genesis 36:8)...
    - The Sons of Esau:
      1. Eliphaz
      2. Reuel

# Psalms 83

- The tabernacles of Edom... (Psalms 83:6a)
  - The Sons of Eliphaz (The Bible calls them “Dukes”)
    - Teman (He had a son named Eliphaz who was one of Job’s friends)
    - Omar
    - Zepho
    - Gatam
    - Kanaz
    - Amalek (born to Timna, Eliphaz’s concubine, this is why he is named last and is considered the lowest ranking Duke of this family line. Apparently, a lot of resentment because of this!)

- The tabernacles of ... the Ishmaelites... (Psalms 83:6b)
  - The Twelve Sons of Ishmael (also called “Dukes”):
    - Nebajoth
    - Kedar
    - Adbeel
    - Mibsam
    - Mishma
    - Dumah
    - Massa
    - Hadar
    - Tema
    - Jetur
    - Naphish
    - Kedemah

\*Notice that both Esau and Ishmael have twelve tribes in their lineage...


# Psalms 83

A feast is made for laughter, and wine maketh merry: but money answereth all things. (Ecclesiastes 10:19)

- The tabernacles of ... the Hagarines... (Psalms 83:6c)
  - Literally the “mixed peoples” and “fugitives” that fought with the tribes of Rueben and Gad. **הַגְּרִיִּים**
    - And in the days of Saul they made war with the Hagarites, who fell by their hand: and they dwelt in their tents throughout all the east land of Gilead. (I Chronicles 5:10)
    - And they made war with the Hagarites, with Jetur, and Nephish, and Nodab. And they were helped against them, and the Hagarites were delivered into their hand, and all that were with them: for they cried to Elohim in the battle, and he was intreated of them; because they put their trust in him. (I Chronicles 5:19-20)

# Psalms 83

- Gebal, and Ammon, and Amalek; the Philistines with the inhabitants of Tyre;
- Assur also is joined with them: they have helped the children of Lot. Selah. (Psalms 83:7-8)
  - Gebal – Related to Tyre (in what is now Lebanon) and from the same area.
  - Philistines – Our modern-day Palestinians like to see themselves this way.
  - Ammon – The younger son of Lot via his daughter-in-law
    - Notice that Moab, the other son of Lot is missing from this scenario...
  - Amalek – One of the Dukes of Edom... the ancestor of Nazi Germany.
  - Assur – The most ancient tribe mentioned here. The Assyrians are some of the descendants of Nimrod, the “horned hunter.” (Genesis 10:11)

# Psalms 83

- Do unto them as unto the Midianites;
  - References to Gideon, who destroyed the rest of the Midianites. (Judges 7:20, II Chronicles 20:20)
  - Gideon did not need a lot of men, 300 would defeat the Midianites and the Amalekites.
    - He eliminated those who were afraid.
    - He eliminated those who were careless.
    - He created panic and shock in the hearts of the Midianites. Once they got them on the run, the rest of the Israelites who were not selected got to “mop up.”
- Make their nobles like Oreb, and like Zeeb: yea, all their princes as Zebah, and as Zalmunna:
  - These princes and kings of Midian were slain by Gideon. (Judges 8:21)
  - The Israelis seem to have done this to Yassir Arafat??? The *Mossad* has done this to other leaders of the Palestinian Movement.
- Who said, Let us take to ourselves the houses of Elohim in possession. (Psalms 83:9, 11, 12b)

# Psalms 83

- as to Sisera, as to Jabin, at the brook of Kison...
  - Jabin was a king in Canaan who oppressed the Israelites, the king was killed by a woman. Deborah was the Judge in charge of Israel at the time. (Judges 4-5)
  - And the children of Israel again did evil in the sight of YHWH, when Ehud was dead. And YHWH sold them into the hand of Jabin king of Canaan, that reigned in Hazor; the captain of whose host was Sisera, which dwelt in Harosheth of the Gentiles. And the children of Israel cried unto YHWH: for he had nine hundred chariots of iron; and twenty years he mightily oppressed the children of Israel. (Judges 4:1-3)

# Psalms 83

- as to Sisera, as to Jabin, at the brook of Kison...
  - Jabin was a king in Canaan who oppressed the Israelites, the king was killed by a woman. Deborah was the Judge in charge of Israel at the time. (Judges 4-5)
  - And YHWH discomfited Sisera, and all his chariots, and all his host, with the edge of the sword before Barak; so that Sisera lighted down off his chariot, and fled away on his feet. But Barak pursued after the chariots, and after the host, unto Harosheth of the Gentiles: and all the host of Sisera fell upon the edge of the sword; and there was not a man left. Howbeit Sisera fled away on his feet to the tent of Jael the wife of Heber the Kenite: for there was peace between Jabin the king of Hazor and the house of Heber the Kenite. (Judges 4:15-17)
  - Then Jael Heber's wife took a nail of the tent, and took an hammer in her hand, and went softly unto him, and smote the nail into his temples, and fastened it into the ground: for he was fast asleep and weary. So he died. And, behold, as Barak pursued Sisera, Jael came out to meet him, and said unto him, Come, and I will shew thee the man whom thou seekest. And when he came into her tent, behold, Sisera lay dead, and the nail was in his temples. (Judges 4:21-22)

# Psalms 83

- Which perished at Endor: they became as dung for the earth.
  - These men remained unburied. This references what happened to King Saul because he consulted a medium at Endor (a town of Manasseh). (I Samuel 28:1-25)
  - And when Saul saw the host of the Philistines, he was afraid, and his heart greatly trembled.
  - And when Saul inquired of YHWH, YHWH answered him not, neither by dreams nor by Urim, nor by prophets.
  - Then said Saul unto his servants, Seek me a woman that hath a familiar spirit, that I may go to her, and inquire of her. And his servants said to him, Behold, there is a woman that hath a familiar spirit at Endor. (I Samuel 28:5-7)
- Who said, Let us take to ourselves the houses of Elohim in possession. (Psalms 83:11-12)



# Psalms 83

- As the fire burneth a wood, and as the flame setteth the mountains on fire;
- So persecute them with thy tempest, and make them afraid with thy storm.
- Fill their faces with shame; that they may seek thy name, O YHWH. (Psalms 83:14-16)

# Psalms 83

- Let them be confounded and troubled for ever; yea, let them be put to shame, and perish:
- That men may know that thou, whose name alone is YHWH, art the most high over all the earth. (Psalms 83:17-18)
