Seventh Bowl of Judgment Upon the Earth

- And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done.
- And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great.
- And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before YHWH, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath. (Revelation 16:17-19)

The Beginnings of Babylon

- The Repopulation of the Earth After the Flood.
- The Story of Nimrod
 - And the sons of Cush; Seba, and Havilah, and Sabtah, and Raamah, and Sabtecha: and the sons of Raamah; Sheba, and Dedan. (*cf.* Ezekiel 38:13)
 - And Cush begat Nimrod: he began to be a mighty one in the earth.
 - He was a mighty hunter before YHWH: wherefore it is said, Even as Nimrod the mighty hunter before YHWH. (Genesis 10:7-9)
 - Some scholars suggest Nimrod was a *Nephilim*.
 - Cush may have permitted his wife to mate with a “son of Elohim.”




The Beginnings of Babylon


- The Story of Nimrod

- And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel (Babylon), and Erech, and Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar.
- Out of that land went forth Asshur, and builded Nineveh, and the city Rehoboth, and Calah,
- And Resen between Nineveh and Calah: the same is a great city.
(Genesis 10:7-12)
 - בבל Babel or Babylon = “confusion (by mixing)”
 - This is the first time the Hebrew word (ממלכה) for kingdom is used.
 - Pay Attention to Asshur (אשור) = Asshur, Ashur, or Assyria = “a step”
 - We never read about Resen again... what happened?

- And the whole earth was of one language, and of one speech.
- And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east, that they found a plain in the land of Shinar; and they dwelt there.
- And they said one to another, Go to, let us make brick, and burn them thoroughly. And they had brick for stone, and slime had they for mortar. (Genesis 11:1-3)

The Tower of Babel


- And they said, Go to, let us build us a city and a tower, whose top may reach unto heaven; and let us make us a name, lest we be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth.
- And YHWH came down to see the city and the tower, which the children of men builded. (Genesis 11:4-5)

The Tower of Babel

- And YHWH said, Behold, the people is one, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do. (Genesis 11:6)
 - Olaf H. Hage III:
 - These builders had seemingly overcome a key technological barrier or had revived some advanced pre-Flood *Nephilim* technology.
 - On the other hand, “sins reaching unto heaven” (Revelation 18:5) may refer to space exploration by Babylon the Great. Revelation’s Greek says *achri* (ἀχρι): “as far as heaven.”



The Tower of Babel

- Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech.
- So YHWH scattered them abroad from thence upon the face of all the earth: and they left off to build the city.
- Therefore is the name of it called Babel; because YHWH did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did YHWH scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth. (Genesis 11:7-9)

The Judgment of the King of Babylon

- That thou shalt take up this proverb against the king of Babylon, and say, How hath the oppressor ceased! the golden city ceased! (Isaiah 14:4)
- How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer (Heb: הִלֵּל *Hillel*), son of the morning! (son of *Sokar* the Egyptian Title for the Prince of Darkness) how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!
- For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of *El* (god): I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north (Heb: צִפּוֹן *Typhon*):
- I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. (Isaiah 14:12-14)

The Judgment of the King of Babylon

- Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell (*Strong's* #7585 שְׁאוֹל *she'ol*), to the sides of the pit.
- They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, and consider thee, saying, Is this the man (Hillel/Lucifer) that made the earth to tremble, that did shake kingdoms;
- That made the world as a wilderness, and destroyed the cities thereof; that opened not the house of his prisoners?
- All the kings of the nations, even all of them, lie in glory, every one in his own house. (Isaiah 14:15-18)



The Judgment of the King of Babylon

- Most commentators insist upon taking Isaiah's "Lucifer" passage out of context.
- This passage is explicitly about the "King of Babylon" who has "children" and is specifically identified as a "man," who seeks to ascend to the realm of "the stars."
- He is a human son of *Sokar* (Heb: שֹׁהַר the Egyptian Prince of Darkness, not necessarily "the morning" as most Bible translations render it. (Hart 2005) (Ancient Egypt Online 2018)
- He is enthroned on "Armageddon" in Isaiah. He also travels up to Typhon (the "North"), whose arrival will usher in the reign of the Beast.
- This is clearly a description of the Beast, he is not Satan, but Satan's son or heir (Revelation 13:2).



The Judgment of the King of Babylon

- The Hebrew word for “howl” is Strong’s #3213 (יָלַל) or *yalal*. This word is a verb. It appears 35 times in the Old Testament.
- When you insert a Hebrew letter ה (Heth) in front of a Hebrew word, it is like inserting a “the” in front of the word, as in “The Howling.” This is also a title for a 1981 movie that was very popular. It was about a serial killer in small town.
- This title was also given to another movie done by a British studio (Greenway Entertainment) in 2017. The story is about a strange man named “Rathbone” who was obsessed with his ungodly animal and human modification experiments!
- Greenway Entertainment (U.K.) has done a number of horror flicks including a short-story series called *The Soul Catcher*. This fallen angel cannot leave earth until he has extracted 666 “souls of the damned.”



The Judgment of the King of Babylon

- The Hebrew word for “praise” is *Strong’s* #1984 (הלל) or *halal*. This word is a verb. It appears 166 times in the Old Testament.
- Hillel (*Strong’s* #1985 הלל) was also the father of a Judge in Israel. The Pharisees put a Nikud (vowel point) after the first Lamed to differentiate the name of the man from the word for praise.
- Hillel is also a famous School of Pharisaical Thought.

Lucifer

- Isaiah NEVER uses the word Lucifer. The word he uses is *Hillel* (Hebrew: הִלֵּל *Strong's* #1966) .
- The word “Lucifer” comes from a Medieval Latin translation of the Bible produced in Charlemagne’s time (Around *A.D.* 800). This particular Bible is a revised version of the Roman Catholic Vulgate, produced 1,300 years after Isaiah was written.
- No book in the Bible was ever originally written in Latin!
- Lucifer is only an *elohim* in the Masonic religion. The Bible never gives him that honor!



Who is the “King” of Babylon?

- In Nimrod’s time, was Babylon was the first to travel into space? The civilization was obliterated and confused. The only time YHWH has ever judged a civilization in that manner.
- In Isaiah’s time, he was Hillel, the sorcerer, who was able to engage in space travel. He was judged, brought back to earth, and humiliated!

Who is the “King” of Babylon?

- In the End Times, the beasts manifest as political systems, just as Daniel predicted.
 - And four great beasts came up from the sea, diverse one from another. (Daniel 7:3)
 - These beasts were political systems, NOT specific rulers!
 1. A Lion with Eagle’s Wings – it was lifted from the earth – stood as a man
 2. Bear – It raised up itself on one side – it had three ribs in its mouth
 3. Leopard – four wings on its back – dominion was given to it

Who is the “King” of Babylon?

- And four great beasts came up from the sea, diverse one from another. (Daniel 7:3)
- 4. The Terrible Beast – Shown only in Night Visions – dreadful, terrible, strong exceedingly – had great iron teeth – diverse from the other beasts – has ten horns!
 - One Little Horn plucks up three of the original horns!
 - This will leave the Seven Royal Families in Power
 - It has the eyes of a man! (This could relate to all the spying the Beast Government does)
 - A mouth speaking great things!
 - Speaks words against the Most High!
 - Shall wear out the saints!
 - “Think” to change times and laws!
 - They shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of times...
 - $y = (x + 2x) + (2x/n)$
 - Where $x =$ “time” and $2x$ is times, we use “ n ” for the dividing of times because the verse does not specify the exact division of “times.”

The Judgment of “King” of Babylon?

- At the end, all these thrones were cast down!
- The “Ancient of Days” sat on a new throne!
 - His garment was “white as snow.”
 - The Hair of His Head like the pure wool.
 - The throne was like a fiery flame.
 - His wheels (Aramaic: ܠܓܠܓ) as Burning Fire.
- A thousand, thousands ministered unto him
- Judgment was set, and the books were opened:
 - The fourth beast was slain, his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame
 - The other three beasts had their dominion taken away, but the lives were prolonged for a “season and time.”

Who is the “King” of Babylon?

- Babylon is a spirit that infects countries seeking world domination. When it is done dealing with a nation, it ends up on the historical “trash heap.”
 - If you study the passage in Isaiah 14, Hillel is also called “red.” The Hebrew word for “red” is Edom. Remember, Esau was red.
 - The Beast in Revelation 17:3 was red.
 - Herod the Great and his family were Edomites.
 - The word “Rothchild” means “Red Shield.”
 - They took economic control of the West (excluding the USA) in the early 19th century. They took over control of the USA in 1913 when the Federal Reserve Act was passed by a “voice vote” on December 23, 1913.

Who is the “King” of Babylon?

- And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels, And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven. (Revelation 12:7-8)
 - These wars are fought in the heavens. When the dragon lost, he was sent to the earth. The King of Babylon, the son of Satan, desires to get back to space so he can again war with Yahuwah, hoping for a different result.
 - Several Beast systems have desired to reach the heavens. Why?



Who is the “King” of Babylon?

- When World War II was over, the United States, Great Britain, and the Soviet Union (Russia) imported Nazi German Scientists and Technicians (via Operation Paperclip) to start up their own space programs.
- The Megastructures of Mars were theoretically constructed using *Nephilim* technologies learned from their fathers, the fallen “sons of god.”
- Though thou exalt thyself as the eagle, and though thou set thy nest among the stars, thence will I bring thee down, saith YHWH. (Obadiah 4)



The Harlot and the Beast

- And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will shew unto thee the judgment of the great whore that sitteth upon many waters:
- With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication.
- So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns. (Revelation 17:1-3)

- And here is the mind which hath wisdom. The seven heads are seven mountains, on which the woman sitteth. (Revelation 17:9)

The Harlot and the Beast

- And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space. (Revelation 17:10)
 1. Egypt (Cain was its Father, they called him Osirus)
 2. Assyria (Ashur) – They never conquered Egypt, but they assimilated much of their occult religion.
 3. Babylon – Nebuchadnezzar did conquer Egypt but they already used the religion, which they took when they conquered Assyria.
 4. Medio-Persia – They conquered Babylon...
 5. Macedonia (Alexander the Great) – Also conquered Egypt...
 6. Rome (The Major ruling power in *A.D.* 62) – Also conquered Egypt...
 7. ???

The Harlot and the Beast

- The Old Testament Parallel to Revelation 17:10 in Daniel 2:31-45:
 - The Great Image of Daniel
 - Head of Fine Gold – Babylon/Egypt
 - Breast and Arms of Silver - Persia
 - Belly and Thighs of Brass – Macedonia/Greece/Rome
 - Legs of Iron – Final Beast System
 - Feet and toes part of iron and part of clay – The Ten Royal Families
 - A Stone Cut Without Hands – Smote the Image “Upon his Feet that were of Iron and Clay, and brake them into pieces!”
 - The Image was collapsed, broken into very small pieces like chaff and the wind carried it away.
 - The Stone Became a Great Mountain that Fills the Earth

The Ten Royal Families of Europe

1. House of Windsor (Great Britain)
2. House of Capetian-Bourbon (France-Spain-Luxembourg)
3. House of Hapsburg (Austria-Hungary)
4. House of Hohenzollern (Prussia – Germany)
5. House of Cronenberg (West Germany)
6. House of Wittelsbach (Bavaria)
7. House of Bernadotte (Sweden)
8. House of Orange-Nassau (The Netherlands)
9. House of Romanov (Russia)
10. House of Wettin (Belgium, Bulgaria, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland)

The Harlot and the Beast

- And whereas thou sawest iron mixed with miry clay, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men:
 - They will again try to mix the “sons of Elohim” with the “daughters of men,” just like they did in Genesis 6:2-4.
 - The same scenario was attempted in Genesis 19:9 when they attempted a homosexual union with the angels that were in Lot’s house.
- but they shall not cleave one to another, even as iron is not mixed with clay. (Daniel 2:43)
 - Unfortunately for them, this time, their genetics had changed so much that this time, they could not create *Nephilim* like they did in Genesis 6:2-4.
 - Their experiments will create *Nephilim*, but they will not hold together.

The Harlot and the Beast

- And the ten horns which thou sawest are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast.
- These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast. (Revelation 17:12-13)
 - The ten kings are the royal families of Europe, seeking to regain the power they had in the 19th century.
 - The Beast will give them the power to complete this task.

The Harlot and the Beast

- These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Master of masters, and King of kings: and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful.
(Revelation 17:14)
 - This is not a progression. The Book of Revelation was given to John Mark in pieces. He was a scribe of the Tribe of Benjamin and papyrus was hard to come by and cost a lot of money.
 - This statement just tells us what will happen to them. Chapter 18 will tell us how that will happen.

The Harlot and the Beast

- And in the days of these kings shall the *Elohim* of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand for ever.
- Forasmuch as thou sawest that the stone was cut out of the mountain without hands, and that it brake in pieces the iron, the brass, the clay, the silver, and the gold; the great *Elohim* hath made known to the king what shall come to pass hereafter: and the dream is certain, and the interpretation thereof sure. (Daniel 2:44-45)

The Harlot and the Beast

- And he saith unto me, The waters which thou sawest, where the whore sitteth, are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and tongues.
- And the ten horns which thou sawest upon the beast, these shall hate the whore, and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire. (Revelation 17:15-16)
 - These ten royal families will effectively rule the world.
 - But they will resent, eventually hate, and will finally destroy the whore that tries to control them.

The Harlot and the Beast

- For YHWH hath put in their hearts to fulfil his will, and to agree, and give their kingdom unto the beast, until the words of YHWH shall be fulfilled.
- And the woman which thou sawest is that great city, which reigneth over the kings of the earth. (Revelation 17:17-18)
 - When they have disposed of the harlot, then, they will hand their domains over to the Beast system.
 - Remember, beasts are hard to control and can turn on their master at a moment's notice.
