





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The End Time Day of the LORD

- Maj. Tom Baird (ret.) has been studying this topic for several years and in connection with this study, the LORD has given him prophecies to improve our understandings with these studies.
- All of these prophecies are connected in some manner to scriptures the LORD has already given to us in the Bible.
- Sometimes, when these prophecies are received, they refer to scriptures that we are often unaware of or do not understand until we receive these prophecies.

The End Time Day of the LORD

- To do this analysis properly, we will first review the prophecy the Major has received.
- Second, we will search the Bible to find scriptures that either support or disprove the prophecy the Major has seen.
 - Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge. If any thing be revealed to another that sitteth by, let the first hold his peace. For ye may all prophesy one by one, that all may learn, and all may be comforted. And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets. For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints. (I Corinthians 14:29-33)

The End Time Day of the LORD

- Kings David and Solomon frequently quoted the Torah (the only part of the Bible they had access to) in their writings to validate their own writings.
- The Prophets spent much of their time teaching the Torah (the wisdom and the history) from a prophetic perspective.
 - Often, when they did predict the future, it was often in connection with a teaching from the Torah (Law)!
 - Only rarely did their prophecies predict the future!

Prophets vs. Soothsayers

- The Devil's prophet's foretell the future to gain attention for themselves. They are called soothsayers:
 - The Hebrew word (Strong's #6049) is עֲנֵן or *Anon*. Where have we heard that word before? Ever heard of a conservative poster named Q-Anon? (<https://qanon.pub/>)
 - And it shall come to pass, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the bow shall be seen in the cloud: And I will remember my covenant, which is between me and you and every living creature of all flesh; and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh. (Genesis 9:14-15)
 - Ye shall not eat any thing with the blood: neither shall ye use enchantment, nor observe times. (Leviticus 19:26)

Prophets vs. Soothsayers

- The Devil's prophet's foretell the future to gain attention for themselves. They are called soothsayers:
 - The Hebrew word (Strong's #6049) is עֲנִי or *Anon*. Where have we heard that word before? Ever heard of a conservative poster named Q-Anon? (<https://qanon.pub/>)
 - There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. (Deuteronomy 18:10-11)
 - For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do. (Deuteronomy 18:14)

Prophets vs. Soothsayers

- The Devil's prophet's foretell the future to gain attention for themselves. They are called soothsayers:
 - The Hebrew word (Strong's #6049) is עֲנִי or *Anon*. Where have we heard that word before? Ever heard of a conservative poster named Q-Anon? (<https://qanon.pub/>)
 - And Gaal spake again and said, See there come people down by the middle of the land, and another company come along by the plain of Meonenim (regarders of the times). (Judges 9:37)
 - They had occult communities in biblical times.

Prophets vs. Soothsayers

- The Devil's prophet's foretell the future to gain attention for themselves. They are called soothsayers:
 - The Hebrew word (Strong's #6049) is עֲנִי or *Anon*. Where have we heard that word before? Ever heard of a conservative poster named Q-Anon? (<https://qanon.pub/>)
 - And he caused his children to pass through the fire in the valley of the son of Hinnom: also he observed times, and used enchantments, and used witchcraft, and dealt with a familiar spirit, and with wizards: he wrought much evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.
 - And he set a carved image, the idol which he had made, in the house of God, of which God had said to David and to Solomon his son, In this house, and in Jerusalem, which I have chosen before all the tribes of Israel, will I put my name for ever:
 - Neither will I any more remove the foot of Israel from out of the land which I have appointed for your fathers; so that they will take heed to do all that I have commanded them, according to the whole law and the statutes and the ordinances by the hand of Moses. (II Chronicles 33:6-8)

Prophets vs. Soothsayers

- The Devil's prophet's foretell the future to gain attention for themselves. They are called soothsayers:
 - The Hebrew word (Strong's #6049) is עֲנִי or *Anon*. Where have we heard that word before? Ever heard of a conservative poster named Q-Anon? (<https://qanon.pub/>)
 - Therefore hearken not ye to your prophets, nor to your diviners, nor to your dreamers, nor to your enchanters, nor to your sorcerers, which speak unto you, saying, Ye shall not serve the king of Babylon:
 - For they prophesy a lie unto you, to remove you far from your land; and that I should drive you out, and ye should perish. (Jeremiah 27:9-10)

- The Devil's prophet's foretell the future to gain attention for themselves. They are called soothsayers:
 - The Hebrew word (Strong's #6049) is עֲנִי or *Anon*. Where have we heard that word before? Ever heard of a conservative poster named Q-Anon? (<https://qanon.pub/>)
 - Therefore thou hast forsaken thy people the house of Jacob, because they be replenished from the east, and are soothsayers like the Philistines, and they please themselves in the children of strangers. (Isaiah 2:6)
 - And I will cut off witchcrafts out of thine hand; and thou shalt have no more soothsayers: Thy graven images also will I cut off, and thy standing images out of the midst of thee; and thou shalt no more worship the work of thine hands. (Micah 5:12-13)

Prophets vs. Soothsayers

- The Devil's prophet's foretell the future to gain attention for themselves. They are called soothsayers:
 - Another Hebrew word (Strong's #7080) is **קסם** or *qasam*.
 - Balaam also the son of Beor, the soothsayer, did the children of Israel slay with the sword among them that were slain by them. (Joshua 13:22)
 - Balaam is NEVER called a prophet, anywhere in the Bible!
 - Of the 17 times this word is used, it is translated:
 - diviner = 7
 - prudent = 1
 - divine = 5
 - soothsayer = 1
 - divination = 1
 - divining = 1

Prophets vs. Soothsayers

- The Devil's prophet's foretell the future to gain attention for themselves. They are called soothsayers:
 - Another Hebrew word (Strong's #7080) is קסם or *qasam*. The most curious translation is this one:
 - FOR, behold, the Lord, the LORD of hosts, doth take away from Jerusalem and from Judah the stay and the staff, the whole stay of bread, and the whole stay of water, The mighty man, and the man of war, the judge, and the prophet, and the prudent, and the ancient, The captain of fifty, and the honourable man, and the counsellor, and the cunning artificer, and the eloquent orator. (Isaiah 3:1-3)

Prophets vs. Soothsayers

- The Devil's prophet's foretell the future to gain attention for themselves. They are called soothsayers:
 - The Aramaic word for soothsayer is (Strong's #1505) גִּזְרָא or *Gezar*. It is found six times in the Book of Daniel:
 - Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet *that were* of iron and clay, and brake them to pieces. (Daniel 2:34)
 - Forasmuch as thou sawest that the stone was cut out of the mountain without hands, and that it brake in pieces the iron, the brass, the clay, the silver, and the gold; the great God hath made known to the king what shall come to pass hereafter: and the dream is certain, and the interpretation thereof sure. (Daniel 2:45)

Prophets vs. Soothsayers

- Biblical altars are not to be made of hewn or cut stone:
 - And if thou wilt make me an altar of stone, thou shalt not build it of hewn stone: for if thou lift up thy tool upon it, thou hast polluted it. (Exodus 20:25)
 - And there shalt thou build an altar unto the LORD thy God, an altar of stones: thou shalt not lift up any iron tool upon them. (Deuteronomy 27:5)
 - Then Joshua built an altar unto the LORD God of Israel in mount Ebal, As Moses the servant of the LORD commanded the children of Israel, as it is written in the book of the law of Moses, an altar of whole stones, over which no man hath lift up any iron: and they offered thereon burnt offerings unto the LORD , and sacrificed peace offerings. (Joshua 8:30-31)

Prophets vs. Soothsayers

- The Devil's prophet's foretell the future to gain attention for themselves. They are called soothsayers:
 - The Aramaic word for soothsayer is (Strong's #1505) גִּזְרִי or *Gezar*. It is found six times in the Book of Daniel:
 - Daniel answered in the presence of the king, and said, The secret which the king hath demanded cannot the wise men, the astrologers, the magicians, the soothsayers, shew unto the king... (Daniel 2:27)
 - The king cried aloud to bring in the astrologers, the Chaldeans, and the soothsayers. And the king spake, and said to the wise men of Babylon, Whosoever shall read this writing, and shew me the interpretation thereof, shall be clothed with scarlet, and have a chain of gold about his neck, and shall be the third ruler in the kingdom. (Daniel 5:7)

Soothsayers in *Julius Caesar*

- The Devil's prophet's foretell the future to gain attention for themselves. They are called soothsayers:
 - The most famous soothsayer in history was found in the Shakespearean tragedy: *Julius Caesar*.
 - The one line the soothsayer said was, "Beware the ides of March!"
 - Julius Caesar did not listen and was murdered on March 15, 44 B.C.
 - March 15 was "tax day" in the Roman Empire, but also the *Feast of Flamen Dialis*, a day when sheep were literally "led to their slaughter" by priests of the god Jupiter (Zeus).
 - The story is told by the Roman historian Plutarch.
 - Suetonius and Cassius Dio considered his death a "religious sacrifice."

Prophets vs. Seers

- Prophets were sometimes called seers, because they could see into the future. However the word was another Hebrew word for prophet:
 - The Hebrew word for seer is (Strong's #7200) רֵאָה or *ra'ah*. It is found ten times in the history books of Israel. The key verse is this one:
 - (Beforetime in Israel, when a man went to inquire of God, thus he spake, Come, and let us go to the seer: for he that is now called a Prophet was beforetime called a Seer.) (I Samuel 9:9)

The End Time Day of the LORD

- These studies discuss the unique end-times Day of the Lord where mankind transitions from our present corrupt rule to God's perfect rule in a single day.
 - And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become *the kingdoms* of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever. (Revelation 11:15)
- This needs to be taken in the context of the Lord's summary of that day as given to me initially on June 22, 2016 and further revealed through additional scriptures on September 7, 2018.
- With this prophecy we begin.

The Prophecy I

- Thus saith the Lord,
 - This is the day of the Lord I have given you.
 - A day of rejoicing and a day of weeping; A day of Salvation, and a day of calamity.
 - For, behold I am coming soon, and this day will be like none other.
 - It has never been before, nor shall it ever be again.
 - Prepare yourselves lest you be destroyed in it.
 - Behold all heaven is filled with great anticipation for this day is upon us. It shall be soon.

The Prophecy II

- It shall be soon.
- It has been told in days of old.
- Now, it is come and shall delay no longer.
- Rend your heart, and make way for the Lord.
- Repent, and let Him dwell therein.
- For in that day there shall be no more sin, but sin shall be removed from off the face of the earth.
- I the Lord have declared it, and it shall surely come to pass.

Understanding the Prophecy

- As we shall see, the elements of this prophecy are all contained in the scriptures.
- In the scriptures, the Lord clarifies much of the detail, and emphasizes (in summary form), those points for which He desires us to pay attention.
- If this saying was the pronouncement of a soothsayer, the need to be scriptural would be missing!

Understanding the Prophecy

- This prophecy started my ongoing quest to gather, study, and understand the Lord's "End-Time Day of the Lord."
- My goal was to better understand scripture, not to be the recipient of a prophecy.
- After the Scripture listings we will study the Lord's recent revelation of it being an actual unique 24-hour day of transition from man's corrupt government to the final everlasting government of God.

Analyzing the Prophecy

- Prepare yourselves lest you be destroyed in it.
 - O daughter of Babylon, who art to be destroyed; happy shall he be, that rewardeth thee as thou hast served us. (Psalms 137:8)
 - For the indignation of the LORD *is* upon all nations, and *his* fury upon all their armies: he hath utterly destroyed them, he hath delivered them to the slaughter. (Isaiah 34:2)
 - And I will send a fire on Magog, and among them that dwell carelessly in the isles: and they shall know that I *am* the LORD. (Ezekiel 39:6)

Analyzing the Prophecy

- Prepare yourselves lest you be destroyed in it.
 - I have cut off the nations: their towers are desolate; I made their streets waste, that none passeth by: their cities are destroyed, so that there is no man, that there is none inhabitant. (Zephaniah 3:6)
 - But these, as natural brute beasts, made to be taken and destroyed, speak evil of the things that they understand not; and shall utterly perish in their own corruption... (II Peter 2:12)
 - I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not. (Jude 5)

Analyzing the Prophecy

- Behold all heaven is filled with great anticipation for this day is upon us.
 - AND it shall come to pass, when all these things are come upon thee, the blessing and the curse, which I have set before thee, and thou shalt call them to mind among all the nations, whither the LORD thy God hath driven thee,
 - And shalt return unto the LORD thy God, and shalt obey his voice according to all that I command thee this day, thou and thy children, with all thine heart, and with all thy soul;
 - That then the LORD thy God will turn thy captivity, and have compassion upon thee, and will return and gather thee from all the nations, whither the LORD thy God hath scattered thee. (Deuteronomy 30:1-3)

Analyzing the Prophecy

- Behold all heaven is filled with great anticipation for this day is upon us.
 - Who hath heard such a thing? who hath seen such things? Shall the earth be made to bring forth in one day? or shall a nation be born at once? for as soon as Zion travailed, she brought forth her children. (Isaiah 66:8)
 - But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets. (Revelation 10:7)

Analyzing the Prophecy

- Behold all heaven is filled with great anticipation for this day is upon us.
 - It shall be said in that day, Behold our God upon Whom we have waited *and* hoped, that He might save us! This is the Lord, we have waited for Him; we will be glad and rejoice in His salvation. (Isaiah 25:9 AMPC+)
 - Therefore my heart rejoiced and my tongue exulted exceedingly; moreover, my flesh also will dwell in hope (will encamp, pitch its tent, and dwell in hope in anticipation of the resurrection). (Acts 2:26 AMPC+)

Analyzing the Prophecy

- It shall be soon. It has been told in days of old. Now it is come and shall delay no longer.
 - And swore in the name of (by) Him Who lives forever and ever, Who created the heavens (^{N1}sky) and all they contain, and the earth and all that it contains, and the sea and all that it contains. (*He swore*) that no more time should intervene *and* there should be no more waiting or delay... (Revelation 10:6 AMPC+)

Analyzing the Prophecy

- Rend your heart, and make way for the Lord.
 - The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise. (Psalms 51:17)
 - And rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the LORD your God: for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repenteth him of the evil. (Joel 2:13)

Analyzing the Prophecy

- Repent, and let Him dwell therein.
 - For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. (John 3:16)
 - Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call. (Acts 2:38-39)

Analyzing the Prophecy

- Repent, and let Him dwell therein.
 - Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord; And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you: Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began. (Acts 3:19-21)
 - The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. (II Peter 3:9)

Analyzing the Prophecy

- Repent, and let Him dwell therein.
 - Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door (to your heart),* I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me. (Revelation 3:20)

Analyzing the Prophecy

- For in that day there shall be no more sin, but sin shall be removed from off the face of the earth.
 - Consider the case of Noah, Lot, the tribes in the Promised Land before the Exodus, and anyone else who sins on God's land.
 - Behold, the day of the LORD cometh, cruel both with wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate: and he shall destroy the sinners thereof out of it. (Isaiah 13:9)

Analyzing the Prophecy

- For in that day there shall be no more sin, but sin shall be removed from off the face of the earth.
 - But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.
 - *Seeing then that* all these things shall be dissolved, what manner *of persons* ought ye to be in *all* holy conversation and godliness... (II Peter 3:10-11)

Analyzing the Prophecy

- For in that day there shall be no more sin, but sin shall be removed from off the face of the earth.
 - Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?
 - Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.
 - Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless. (II Peter 3:12-14)

Analyzing the Prophecy

- For in that day there shall be no more sin, but sin shall be removed from off the face of the earth.
 - For behold, upon the stone which I have set before Joshua, upon that one stone are seven eyes *or* facets (*the all-embracing providence of God and the sevenfold radiations of the Spirit of God*). Behold, I will carve upon it its inscription, says the Lord of hosts, and I will remove the iniquity *and* guilt of this land in a single day. (Zechariah 3:9 AMPC+)

Analyzing the Prophecy

- I the Lord have declared it, and it shall surely come to pass.
 - So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper *in the thing* whereto I sent it. (Isaiah 55:11)
 - And he said unto me, These sayings *are* faithful and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent his angel to shew unto his servants the things which must shortly be done. (Revelation 22:6)

The Day of the Lord

- On Friday, September 7, 2018, while carefully reading Revelation 5:6 in the Amplified Cross Referenced Bible it led me to Zechariah 3:9. What I found so excited me I could hardly contain it.
- As I studied it out it even made greater significance.

The Single Day of the Lord

- During my ongoing study of the “Lord’s End Time day of the Lord” the *Amplified Cross Referenced Bible* gave me the verse in Zechariah 3:9:
 - For behold, upon the stone which I have set before Joshua, upon that one stone are seven eyes *or facets (the all-embracing providence of God and the sevenfold radiations of the Spirit of God)*. Behold, I will carve upon it its inscription, says the Lord of hosts, and I will remove the iniquity *and* guilt of this land in a single day.

The Single Day of the Lord

- During the gathering of the scriptures of the “Lord’s End-Time Day of the Lord” it had become obvious the scriptures were referring to an actual 24-hour day, but I had not found any scripture that actually and explicitly stated this fact!
- Now, here it was! But, could we be sure?

The Single Day of the Lord

- First, I checked the *Strong's* numbers.
 - Yes, the Hebrew word for day, (יֹם) *yôm* (H3117), does mean “a day,” but it also could mean period of time.
 - *Yom Teruah* (It was September 11, 2018), which means “Day of Trumpets.”
 - *Yom Kipper* (It was September 20, 2018), which means “Day of Atonement.”

The Single Day of the Lord

- Second, I looked up the Hebrew word for “one” as is used as “one day” in the King James Version.
 - Wow! Yes, it means one, but is of greater restriction than we have in English.
 - It is the Hebrew word (אחד) *'echâd* (*Strong's* #259). Not only does it mean the numeral one, but it carries with it the restriction of “only,” “unique” or “single.” God is making a statement!

The Single Day of the Lord

- Now, let's consider the preceding part of the phrase, “I will remove the iniquity of the land”
- (מוֹשׁ) *músh* (*Strong's* #4185) and (אֵת) *'êth* (*Strong's* #853) = “remove definitively.”
- (עוֹן/עוֹנִין) *'âvôn* (H5771) = “iniquity” but also carries with it the idea of “guilt.”

*Note also that Avon Books publishes the *Satanic Bible* by the late Anton LaVey. They also publish books encouraging immorality.

The Single Day of the Lord

- So far we have “I will (continuing from the preceding title of ‘Lord of Hosts’) remove definitively the iniquity and guilt.”
- (אֶרֶץ) *'erets* (H776) (Earth or Land) and (הַיָּא/הַיָּא) *hu'* (H1931) (this) = “of this land” or “of this earth.”



The Single Day of the Lord

- So, as we have translated in many places we get:
 - I will remove (specifically) the iniquity *and* guilt of this land (the earth) in a single (unique) day.

The Single Day of the Lord

- Note: This book of Zechariah is addressing the “End Time Day of the Lord” (see Zechariah 14).
- But, this chapter three is about God’s salvation where we find verse 3:8 is addressing the High Priest “Joshua” whose name means “Yahovah is Salvation.”

The Single Day of the Lord

- This chapter is God's "Christ-O-Type" of Jesus' Salvation achieved on the Cross in one day, but it is also a pattern that speaks specifically to a future day when Jesus establishes His literal Kingdom rule on earth in a single day.

The Single Day of the Lord

- Also look at Isaiah.
 - Who hath heard such a thing? who hath seen such things? Shall the earth be made to bring forth in one day? *or* shall a nation be born at once? for as soon as Zion travailed, she brought forth her children. (Isaiah 66:8)
- Here again we have modern day Israel born, but also a pattern for the Lord's single day establishment of His Kingdom.

The Single Day of the Lord

- Not only does the Prophecy and Prophetic Scripture state the removal of iniquity is in the Day of the Lord, but another revelation given to a fourteen-year-old secular Jewish boy who died, went to heaven and hell, and returned also was given this same message that it is in one single day.
