

The Word for Today 25 Apr 2021 Dream Breakthrough

On the weekend of the 17th and 18th of April 2021 a voice came unto me in my sleep and said,
“Breakthrough.”

Then I saw before me two ceramic tiles like those of a countertop. They were coated in burned dark black deposits as if from a BBQ grill. Written in this black was displayed, "Ancient Evil." (In a later repeat of this dream the black layer was also full of maggots.) I was given a brush about the size of a toothbrush and commanded to scrub them. The brush appeared to be the Word of God. - (2) Bless YHWH, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:
- (3) Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; ¹ who healeth all thy diseases; ²
- (4) Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies;
- (5) Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's.
- (6) YHWH executeth righteousness and judgment for all that are oppressed.
- (7) He made known his ways unto Moses, his acts unto the children of Israel.

- (8) YHWH is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy.
- (9) He will not always chide: neither will he keep his anger for ever.
- (10) He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities.
- (11) For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him.
- (12) As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us.
- (13) Like as a father pitieth his children, so YHWH pitieth them that fear him.
- (14) For he knoweth our frame; he remembereth that we are dust.
- (15) As for man, his days are as grass: as a flower of the field, so he flourisheth.
- (16) For the wind passeth over it, and it is gone; and the place thereof shall know it no more.
- (17) But the mercy of YHWH is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children;
- (18) To such as keep his covenant, and to those that remember his commandments to do them.
- (19) YHWH hath prepared his throne in the heavens; and his kingdom ruleth over all.
- (20) Bless YHWH, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word.
- (21) Bless ye YHWH, all ye his hosts; ye ministers of his, that do his pleasure.
- (22) Bless YHWH, all his works in all places of his dominion: bless YHWH, O my soul.

Let us daily repent, receive His forgiveness, live in His Righteousness and awesome fear of the Lord.
